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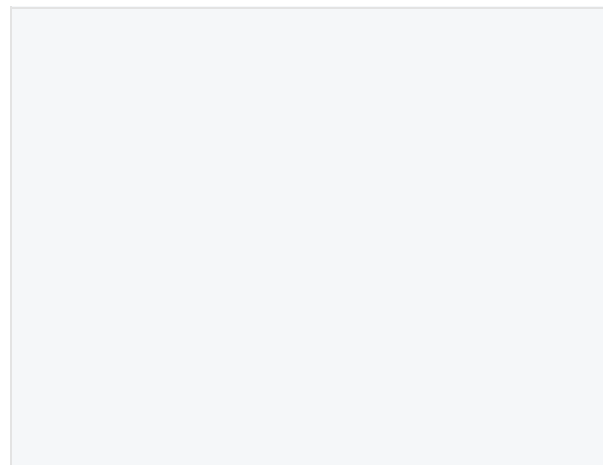
Exergen Corporation Donates \$10,000 to The One Fund Boston in Honor of Boston Marathon Medical Team
